IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When used in the directed manner, this unit has been designed and manufactured to ensure your personal safety. However, improper use can result in potential electrical shock or fire hazards. Please read all safety and operating instructions carefully before installation and use, and keep these instructions handy for future reference. Take special note of all warnings listed in these instructions and on the unit.

- The apparatus and AC adapter shall not be exposed to dripping and splashing and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus and AC adapter.
- The plug of the AC adapter is used as the disconnect device. The AC adapter should always remain readily accessible and should not be obstructed.
- 3. To completely disconnect the apparatus, unplug the adapter from the power outlet.
- Minimum distance of 4 inches (10cm) around the apparatus and AC adapter should be made available for sufficient ventilation.
- 5. The ventilation should not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings with items such as newspapers, table clothes, curtains, etc.
- 6. No open flame sources such as lighted candles should be placed on the apparatus.
- 7. The apparatus and AC adapter should be used in moderate climates.
- 8. Do not attempt to dismantle, open or repair this product yourself. If a fault occurs, seek advice from your local qualified service technician or contact the distributor via the telephone number at the back of this instruction manual.
- 9. The rating plate of the apparatus is located on the rear of the unit.

IMPORTANT NOTES

Avoid installing unit in locations described below:

- Places exposed to direct sunlight or close to heat radiating appliances such as electric heaters.
- Places subject to constant vibrations.
- Dusty, humid or moist places.

COMPLIANCE WITH FCC REGULATIONS

This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:

- (1) this device may not cause harmful interference, and
- (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.

PROTECT YOUR FURNITURE!

This model is equipped with non-skid rubber 'feet' to prevent the product from moving when you operate the controls. These 'feet' are made from non-migrating rubber material specially formulated to avoid leaving any marks or stains on your furniture. However certain types of oil based furniture polishes, wood preservatives, or cleaning sprays may cause the rubber 'feet' to soften, and leave marks or a rubber residue on the furniture. To prevent any damage to your furniture we strongly recommend that you purchase small self-adhesive felt pads, available at hardware stores and home improvement centers everywhere, and apply these pads to the bottom of the rubber 'feet' before you place the product on fine wooden furniture.



LOCATION OF CONTROLS






1	Power/Status Indicator	4	Power On/Off Switch

3	AUX IN Jack	6	USB Charging Port (DC5V 1A)


PLAYING MUSIC FROM A BLUETOOTH ENABLED DEVICE

 Make sure the Power On/Off Switch is in OFF position. Insert the DC plug of the AC adapter (Included) into the DC Input Jack at the back of the unit.





Connect the AC adapter to an AC 120V~ 60Hz power source. Use the Power On/Off Switch to turn the unit ON or OFF.



- Turn on the unit by sliding the Power On/Off Switch to "ON". A short melody will be heard. The Power/Status Indicator should light and flash in blue.
- 4. If the unit has never been paired/linked with a Bluetooth enabled device before, you need to follow the pairing instructions below:
 - Turn on the Bluetooth function of your device and enable the search or scan function to find the unit.
 - b) Select "KT4557A" from the device list when it appears on your screen. Auto pairing between the unit and your Bluetooth enabled device will proceed.

NOTE: If you are pairing (linking) the unit to your Bluetooth enabled computer, you may need to set the KT4557A as the default sound device.


- 5. After turning on, the unit will search for the last paired device.
- On successful pairing with your Bluetooth enabled device, you can play music on your device wirelessly from the speaker.
- Adjust the volume on your Bluetooth enabled device to obtain the desired sound level.
 NOTE: All control functions should be achieved from your Bluetooth enabled device.
- 8. If the unit needs to pair with another Bluetooth device, you need to turn off the Bluetooth function of the first device and then repeat step 4 above.
- To turn the unit off, slide the Power On/Off Switch at the back to the OFF position. The Power/Status Indicator will go off.



AUX INPUT OPERATION

The unit provides an auxiliary audio signal input jack for connecting external audio devices like MP3 players, CD players or an iPod (except iPod shuffle 3rd generation) and listen to them through the unit speaker.

- 1. Turn on the unit by sliding the Power On/Off Switch to "ON".
- Plug one end of the included audio cable into the AUX IN jack at back of the unit and the other end into the headphone jack of your external audio device. The flashing blue light of the unit will become steady.





- 3. Turn on the external audio device.
- 4. Adjust the volume control of the external device to obtain the desired sound level.

Notes:

- We recommend connecting the headphone jack of your external audio device to the AUX IN jack on this unit. Then use the volume control on the connected device to adjust the overall sound level.
- If you connect the line out jack of your external audio device to this unit instead, the
 audio level can be very high and most probably you cannot adjust the volume level.
- When using the AUX IN function, the Bluetooth pair (link) will be temporarily disconnected until the audio cable is unplugged.
- Turn the unit off when you have finished listening. Don't forget to switch off the power of your external audio device as well.

CHARGING YOUR PORTABLE DEVICE

This unit features a USB port for charging your portable device (iPod, iPhone, Android enabled device, etc.) when used with the USB charging cord that came with it.

- 1. Turn on the unit by sliding the Power On/Off Switch to "ON".
- Plug one end of the USB cable (not included) into the USB Charging Port located at the back of the unit. Plug the other end of the cord into the device you wish to charge.
- 3. Observe the battery charge indicator on your device to make sure the charging process starts and proceeds normally.
- 4. Unplug the USB cable when your device is fully charged.

CAUTION:

Before charging, please refer to the user manual of the device you wish to charge to make sure the charging current requested does not exceed 1A (1000mA). Overloading the charging circuit may cause permanent damage to the unit and void the warranty.

Notes:

- 1. There will be no charging function when the unit is turned "OFF".
- Some smartphones and portable devices use proprietary USB connections, and circuitry, and may not charge when plugged into the USB port. This includes older iPod models including the iPod classic. Please refer to your device user manual before you attempt to charge them.
- 3. Due to increased power demand, it is normal for the unit to get warm while charging your smartphone or portable device.
- Do not charge your smartphone or other portable devices for over 12 hours continuously.
 Disconnect your smartphone or other portable device from the USB cord once it is fully charged.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- 1. Avoid operating your unit under direct sunlight or in hot, humid or dusty places.
- Keep your unit away from heating appliances and sources of electrical noise such as fluorescent lamps or motors.
- 3. In case of malfunction, unplug the unit from the electrical power outlet immediately.

CLEANING THE UNIT

- To prevent fire or shock hazard, disconnect the AC adapter of your unit from the AC power source when cleaning.
- The unit cabinet may be cleaned with a dust cloth and cared for as other furniture. Use caution when cleaning and wiping the plastic parts.

- If the cabinet becomes dusty, wipe it with a soft dry dust cloth. Do not use any wax or
 polish sprays on the cabinet.
- If the front panel becomes dirty or smudged with fingerprints, it may be cleaned with a soft cloth slightly dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Never use abrasive cloths or polishes as these will damage the finish of your unit permanently.

CAUTION: Never allow any water or other liquids to get inside the unit while cleaning.

90 DAY LIMITED WARRANTY AND SERVICE VALID IN THE U.S.A. ONLY

 - a. It remains in the possession of the original purchaser and proof of purchase is demonstrated.
 - It has not been subjected to accident, misuse, abuse, improper service, usage outside the descriptions and warnings covered within the user manual or non-SPECTRA approved modifications.
 - c. Claims are made within the warranty period.
